

Parental Contract

Parents of students in our school are encouraged to participate in their child's education. Parental involvement is essential to student success and therefore essential to the school. We have listed areas where parental support will enhance the student's success.

- 1. I/we understand the teacher's work should supplement that of the parents but is not to take its place. "In all that concerns the well-being of the child, it should be the effort of parents and teachers to cooperate."
- 2. Criticizing the teacher diminishes the effectiveness of the educational experience. I/we believe cooperation with the teacher and administration will improve the academic performance and will contribute to positive behavior characteristics with my child.
- 3. I/we will support the policies in the school handbook. I/we will follow the guidelines described in the handbook with any complaint. Should a concern arise it first will be discussed with the school's teacher(s) and not to other parents or child. If my concern is not resolved at this level, the parent has the right to present it to the local school board.
- 4. Should my child cause property damage to school property or other student's property I am responsible for the cost to repair/replace the damaged property. The school will not be responsible for a student's lost or damaged property.
- 5. Assisting my child in their project-based learning assignments will enhance their learning experience.
- 6. Allowing students time to complete school work at home without interference of "media" interruptions improves my child's learning experience.
- 7. Regular communication with my child's classroom teacher(s) will support the overall success of the learning experience. I/we will help my child to develop a positive attitude about the school.
- 8. Cooperation with the teachers and administration will help my student make measurable growth toward a personal relationship with Jesus.
- 9. I am committed to helping my child understand that growing is often difficult and will require persistence, but our faith in Jesus will give us success.
